Know what is being purchased (last 30 days)

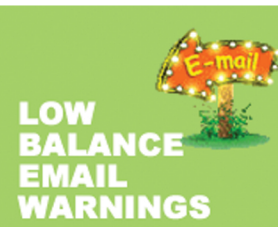
Receive an email when account is low

LUNCH MONEY NOW uses SSL encryption to protect credit card data transmission



Gregory-Portland ISD is going to simplify your life with secure, online credit card deposits.

Lunch Money Now uses a secure connection for processing debit/credit card transactions. The site uses SSL (Secure Sockets Layer) encryption to protect your data (noted by the https: in the URL of the site).

Any data collected by Lunch Money Now is solely for use in making deposits to your student's meal account and processing those charges. No information is shared with third-parties. No credit-card numbers are stored on our server.
